CHAMPION HILLS

Welcome to the 2019 Holiday Season. We are focused on finishing the year strong and both our Membership Satisfaction scores and New Memberships in Q4 will allow us to do so.

A few highlights from our 2019 Membership Survey include:

"Overall, how satisfied are you with your member experience". You scored us a 4.43 out of 5.00, which is a 10% increase over last year and greatly exceeds the Troon Privè median which was 4.19.

Our Net Promoter Score, which asked "How likely would you be to recommend membership to a friend or colleague" was a strong 55.3%, which was a 37% increase over last year's score of 40.4%.

We certainly want to celebrate our successes, however we also realize that we still need to focus on continuous improvement in all areas such as consistency of service, variety of offerings and enhanced programming with the valued feedback you provided.

Some of you also mentioned our long and short term plans for the golf course in the comments section of the survey. As we go through the irrigation project, we are finalizing our strategic plans for the overall golf course conditions, and we will keep you posted as we progress. We also are pleased to announce that the Driving Range Comfort Station Construction began on Oct. 30th and this will be an 8-10 week project. Email updates will be provided as we make progress with J Davis Construction.

We are set for a very strong close to 2019 for membership. Tours are on the rise for membership. We set new tour records for the months of August, September and October! 2018 closed out with 125 membership tours for the entire year. As of October 28, we are YTD at 134 tours.... And we still have two more months!

I'm also excited to report that in the last two months of the year we will welcome 3 new Full Equity members for a year to date total of 15, a former National member will return as a Full Equity member and we will have closed another Corporate Bundle.

I'd like to mention that of these new members, two of them began this season as renters. Renting in Champion Hills has always been pivotal for membership growth and this year is no exception.

Thank you all for welcoming our renters with open arms and making them feel right at home. I've witnessed it countless times at Thirsty Thursday where prospects, renters and new members are welcomed into our Champion Hills family. 


COUNT YOUR ACES

The ball goes straight toward the pin, and before you can even process what has happened, it rolls right into the hole. Two Champion Hills members experienced this feeling less than 24 hours apart from each other on October 3 and 4, 2019.

Lee Weber and Jim Petillo both had ecstatic looks of pride and surprise as they entered the Fazio Pub for their free drink once retiring from the course. Friendly faces and camaraderie filled the pub as the Hole-In-One Club members congratulated the two men for their great accomplishment. It's not every day that someone gets a hole-in-one at Champion Hills but it is even rarer that two members get holes-in-one within 24 hours of each other.

According to the United States Golf Register, the odds of hitting an ace are one in every 33,000 swings. And, on average, a golfer could get a hole-in-one every 330 rounds. Sounds like incredible odds, but at Champion Hills, lightening did strike twice for Jim and 5 times for Lee!


